Monday Sept 20th - Depart The USA

Your adventure begins as you take to the air on the start of your journey in Ireland..

Tuesday Sept 21st-Day 1-Tour of Dublin-Guinness-Teeling Whiskey

Welcome to Ireland! We will meet up with you in the Arrivals area of Dublin Airport and take you on a short tour of Dublin, Ireland's capital city, including the Phoenix Park, the largest walled city park in Europe, before arriving at our first visit of the tour, the Guinness Storehouse, officially the most visited attraction in the Republic of Ireland. And you will find out why when you see the panoramic view of the city from the Gravity Bar, as you learn how to pull a proper pint of 'the Black Stuff'. And if that wasn't enough exposure to Ireland's favorite beverages we will then move on to Teeling Whiskey where you will find out how they magically transform grain into amber heaven - and sample the finished result! We will then leave Dublin and head down to Straffan in County Kildare and our home for the next two nights, the historic [K Club Spa and Country Club](#), a 5-Star Hotel set on a 550 acre estate and, more importantly, the location for the only Ryder Cup that has previously taken place in Ireland. After check-in to the hotel you are invited for a welcome drink with your guides for the tour, who will talk you through the next few days and give some extra suggestions of things to do during your stay. You will have the remainder of the evening free to chill out and enjoy the extensive facilities at the hotel.

Wednesday Sept 22nd - Day 2 - Dublin - First Round Of Golf

The K Club has not one, but two Arnold Palmer designed courses, and today you will get to experience a round of golf on the Palmer South course and, for your convenience, we have arranged clubs and buggies for you with the Club. For those who are not partaking in the golf, and for the golfers following their game, there are a wide range of experiences for you to explore in this world-renowned hotel, ranging from the many country walks around the lakes and rivers on the extensive grounds of the hotel, or perhaps pamper yourself at the K Spa or maybe even have a go at Archery or Falconry, or perhaps fishing or horse-riding or even have a round of tennis or test yourself on the K Golf World Simulator. But leave some time to freshen up, as this evening we have arranged a dinner for you in the hotel after which you will have the remainder of the evening free to relax and enjoy the ambiance of this unique location.

NOTE: A one-day ticket for the Ryder Cup is included as part of the tour package. Our preferred request for our allocation for Ryder Cup tickets is for Saturday, with a second preference of Friday, with Thursday as our third preference. Depending on which day is allocated, the days events listed for the following three days may be interchangeable.

Thursday Sept 23rd-Day 3- Travel To Tralee -Dingle Peninsula -Slea Head

We take our leave of Kildare and travel down to the south-west of Ireland to the town of Tralee in County Kerry (known to the locals as 'The Kingdom'). From there we will venture out onto the Dingle Peninsula and visit the charming fishing town of Dingle, followed by a trip out to view the spectacular scenery at Slea Head. We will then venture to our hotel for the next four nights, the 5-Star [Aghadoe Heights Resort](#), located just outside the world renowned town of Killarney, with fabulous views down over the Lakes of Killarney, where you will have the evening free to relax, or pop in to Killarney to experience the local night life, or catch up on the state of play after the first day of competition at the Ryder Cup.

Friday Sept 24th - Day 4 - Round of Golf #2 At Killarney Golf Course

Today we will have our second round of golf, this time at the spectacular Killarney Golf Course, with spectacular views out over the Lakes of Killarney, which has hosted the Irish Open on six different occasions and was voted Parkland Golf Course Of The Year in 2024. Again we have arranged clubs and buggies for you. For those not availing of the golf, we will arrange for a tour around part of the Ring of Kerry, considered to be one of the most scenic routes in the world. On the completion of the golf, we will return to our hotel, where we have arranged a dinner for you. Finally, you have the opportunity to relax, venture into Killarney, or again catch up on the day's Ryder Cup Golf.

Saturday Sept 25th - Day 5 - Attend Ryder Cup in Adare Manor

Today we will head north to the scenic town of Adare, which, as the name suggests is the location for Adare Manor, and home of the Ryder Cup for 2027. There you will enjoy a day experiencing golf played by some of the very best players in the USA as they take on their equals from Europe in what promises to be a titanic struggle. After the golf we will return you to your hotel where you can catch up on the days golfing highlights, helped down, perhaps, by a drop or two of an Irish beverage!

Sunday Sept 26th-Day 6-Rest Day-Watch Ryder Cup Final Day Coverage

Today you will have an opportunity to sleep late, and rest up, where you will have a free day to explore Killarney and take in coverage of the final days play of the 2027 Ryder Cup as it happens live on TV - accompanied, no doubt, by another couple of pints!

Monday Sept 27th- Day 7 - Rock of Cashel - Return To Dublin - Merry Ploughboy Irish Night

Today we will take our leave of Kerry and head back to Dublin. Along the way we will stop over at the town of Cashel in County Tipperary to visit the iconic Rock of Cashel, plus you will have the opportunity to have lunch in one of the many pubs and eateries there. We will then return to Dublin, where we will check in to your hotel for your final night in Dublin, the [Mespil Hotel](#) located along the banks of the Royal Canal, where you will have a chance to freshen up for the tour finale, a spectacular display of Irish dancing and music in the Merry Ploughboy pub located in the shadows of the Dublin mountains accompanied by a fabulous three course meal, following which we will return you to your hotel.

Monday - Day 8 - The Sad Bit—The Return To The USA

All good things must come to an end, and we now come to the saddest bit of the vacation, the return home. As all US Immigration processes actually take place in Dublin Airport, we need to ensure that you are at the airport in good time to be processed and make your flights. As you will have been pre-processed in Dublin, you will not need to go through immigration when you arrive in the USA and it will be just like arriving on a domestic US flight.

* Flight costs fluctuate frequently, and can be affected by a range of factors such as when the booking is made and availability of unsold remaining seats on a specific flight at a specific time. And, of course, the expectation is that seats will be very much in demand for Ryder Cup Week. Many of our guests have accumulated air miles or have preferred status with a specific airline, and prefer to make their own flight arrangements, upgrade their seating or shop around for the best airline prices. Therefore the main prices quoted above exclude the flight costs, although we can arrange the flights on your behalf, should you wish and will invoice you for the flights separately when the bookings are made. To ensure that you don't miss out on any of your first days activities, we recommend that you arrange a flight that has an early morning arrival time in Dublin Airport on the Tuesday morning (ideally within an hour or so either side of 7.00am Irish time). Because Ireland is five hours ahead of Eastern, this will normally necessitate flying out of the USA on the Monday afternoon. Should you wish to come over on a date before the tour commences we can assist you in finding suitable accommodation for any additional overnight(s) if required. Please also note that the Ryder Cup will not be taking place until September 2027, and most airlines will not open bookings or release prices for their flights until around eleven to twelve months before the departure dates.

** Because the supplement costs on single rooms in Ireland, this can result in them being almost the same price as twin rooms (where the costs are shared between two guests). So if you know another single coming on the trip and don't mind sharing a twin room together, then substantial savings can be made by both of you.

*** We also offer a Payment Plan option that allows you to spread the cost of the remaining balance due, after payment of the deposit, over equal quarterly payments. (Note: we simply divide the balance due by the number of payments, and there are no additional interest or other charges applied).

Because we are an Irish company, all payment amounts are quoted in Euro. The amount payable in US Dollars may be higher or lower depending on the Euro/Dollar exchange rate at the time payments are made.

As there can be considerable costs incurred in bringing your own clubs over from the USA we have arranged for clubs and buggies to be included at both the golf venues. Please indicate any club preferences you might have e.g. left/right-handed, brand, size etc. But please note that choices will be subject to availability and with the best will in the world we cannot guarantee that your requirements can be fully met in all cases.

A 20% non-refundable deposit is payable at the time of booking to reserve your place on the tour. The balance will be due four months prior to the travel date, and will be non-refundable once paid.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- At Ireland US Experience we like to keep things simple, so we don't have reams of tightly packed legal talk that you probably won't ever read or actually understand. What we want to do, when you travel with us, is to ensure that we give you the best possible vacation that we possibly can, and to make sure that you have such an enjoyable and safe time while you are in our care that you will remember and talk about it for years to come. However, there are a few things that we need to highlight to you, so that you are aware of them prior to travelling with us :
- We are an Irish company, based in Ireland, so any bills or invoices we send you will be denominated in Euro. The actual amount in dollars may be higher or lower depending on the actual exchange rate on the dates the payments are made. We currently invoice through Paypal as we find that our visitors are more comfortable making their payments through a payment system that they are familiar with. Please note that you do not need to have a Paypal account to use this facility, and can instead use your debit or credit card as normal via the PayPal Secure Payments Portal, In the same way you would when using on online store. Paypal will automatically handle the Euro/Dollar conversion for you at whatever rate applies at the time that the payment is made.
- Again, because we are an Irish company, based in Ireland, all dealings with us will be deemed to come under the jurisdiction of Irish law and the Irish courts system, or where they might take precedence, the laws of the UK or the European Union.
- Ireland US Experience Ltd undertake to supply the tour services agreed with our clients, which will usually have been customized to their particular requirements. Should any particular service or accommodation become unavailable at the time of the vacation, due to circumstances beyond our control, we agree to replace the missing item with a similar event/hotel of a similar standard. In return for these services, the client confirms that they will pay the amount agreed.
- The Vacation Package will be priced based on an agreed number of passengers on agreed dates. If the number of passengers or dates changes, then this may result in an adjustment to the price per person. Please note, in particular, that single occupancy rooms will normally be more expensive per person than joint occupancy. In addition, hotel accommodation costs tend to increase, and availability can be limited, during the high season (June to August). Hotel prices also tend to be more expensive when bookings are made close to the arrival date, or on different days of the week. Prices quoted by us could therefore require amendment in situations where you request us to change your original travel or accommodation arrangements.
- An initial non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total amount due per person will normally be payable on confirmation of the booking. The remaining balance will be payable four months prior to the commencement of the vacation. We will invoice you, at the appropriate times, for the Euro amounts based on the overall price agreed at the time the booking was made. Final payments, once paid, become non-refundable. We would recommend that when travelling long distances, such as to Ireland, that you take out travel insurance that is appropriate to your circumstances. The websites for many insurance companies will allow you to purchase a range of travel insurance polices online, or If you wished to have a more comprehensive cover, you could consult your insurance advisor.
- All entrance costs to the visitor attractions listed in the itinerary that we agree with our clients are included in the price.
- As a tour operator, we look after you from the moment you arrive at the airport until the moment we return you to the airport at the end of your vacation. We do not usually arrange the flights themselves, but can recommend local US or Irish based travel agents who can supply these services at highly competitive rates. All prices quoted by us therefore exclude flight costs unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that international flight costs fluctuate, and can either increase or decrease substantially the closer you get to your departure date, depending on how full a particular flight might be. In general, flight costs will be higher and availability lower in peak season (June to August), so you will need to take this into account when budgeting the overall cost of the vacation.
- If travellers have any special requirements (e.g. smoking rooms, handicap accessible rooms, bedding type, air conditioning, special dietary requirements) please advise us at time of booking. Once hotels have confirmed, guests may incur penalties from them for any changes. Any special requests are subject to their availability at individual hotels and requests cannot be guaranteed.
- In the unlikely event of a medical emergency or issue, our staff will arrange for local medical assistance and transfer to a local hospital, should that be required. While public healthcare is free in Ireland for emergency admittances, if you wished to have private healthcare facilities (e.g. your own private room) then you will need to ensure that your US health policy covers you for costs incurred outside the USA, or have a suitable travel insurance policy in place to cover any additional costs.
- It is the responsibility of all clients to ensure that they have valid passports before they travel. We recommend that you apply for your passport as early as possible if you do not currently have one, or if it will be out of date prior to your departure/return in order to avoid any last-minute issues. Please ensure, when booking your flights, that you notify the travel agent of the exact names of all travellers as listed on their passports, as the airlines may not allow you to board if the passport name and boarding pass name are different.
- Gratuities to drivers/guides are not included in our prices.
- Any additional Terms and Conditions that might apply to specific vacation packages will be notified to you when agreeing the itinerary.
