Thurs July 16th - Depart The USA

Your journey to Ireland begins as you fly out from the USA across the Atlantic Ocean.

Fri July 17th - Day 1 - Dublin-Kilmainham Gaol-Guinness Storehouse

Welcome to Ireland! Your driver and guide will meet up with you in the Arrivals area of Dublin Airport. As we make our way into the city of Dublin, Ireland's capital city, we will take you on a short tour of some of its many hightlights, including a stop in the Phoenix Park, Europe's largest walled city park, home to roaming deer and the stately Aras an Uachtaráin—Ireland's very own "White House". We will then go back in history, when we pay a visit to Kilmainham Gaol, where you will get to trace the final footsteps of many of Ireland's most famous revolutionary heroes who were imprisoned there over the centuries and where many of them met their final fate. We will then move on to Dublin's most popular locations, the Guinness Storehouse, home of Ireland's most famous export, and also officially the most visited attraction in the Republic of Ireland. From its Gravity Bar, located high above the Storehouse, you will have panoramic views across the whole city, while at the same time learning to pull a proper pint of 'the Black Stuff', and better still getting to taste it! Finally we will check you in to your home for your first two nights in Ireland, the Mespil Hotel, resting along the scenic banks of the Grand Canal, not far from the center of Dublin. Join your guides for a welcome drink as they unveil the full tour—and share insider tips on Dublin's hidden gems. You will have the remainder of the evening free to enjoy the hotel, rest up, maybe take a stroll along the canal banks, visit a local pub or perhaps take a 15-20 minute walk or short cab ride into the city center to the Temple Bar area and experience Dublin's vibrant night life. Remember a pint of Guinness in Ireland is like no other!

Sat July 18th - Day 2 - Dublin - EPIC Museum - Teeling Whiskey

Wake up to a hearty Irish breakfast, then dive into Ireland's global story. Your first stop is the high-tech EPIC Emigration Museum, voted Europe's Leading Tourist Attraction in 2019, 2020 and 2021. Here you will find out why such a small country has had such a major impact all around the world. We will then take a short walk across the road to the Dublin Harbour Quays, to visit the 'Jeanie Johnston', a faithful replica of the type of Famine Ship that was used to take early Irish immigrants to the USA, and famous for the fact that the original ship on which it is based never lost a life in all of its voyages. And, by way of a complete contrast, this afternoon we will visit the home of one of Ireland's other famous beverages, Teeling Whiskey, where you will discover how the simple ingredients of grain, yeast and water are converted into liquid gold, and, of course, you will get to raise a glass and sample some of the end result! You will take in some more of the highlights of Dublin on your way back to your hotel, where you can relax for the evening—or perhaps enjoy another pint or two!

Sun July 19th - Day 3 - Titanic Belfast - Derry - Donegal

We take our leave of Dublin this morning and travel up the East Coast of Ireland to Belfast in Northern Ireland, which is part of the United Kingdom, although you will hardly notice when we cross the border. There you will have a short tour of the city before we dive into Titanic Belfast, crowned the World's Top Visitor Attraction in 2017. Here you'll trace every rivet and blueprint that birthed history's most legendary liner, feel the swell of her grand first-class decks, then relive the heartbreaking night in 1912 when the "unsinkable" met the Atlantic depths. From there we cut across Northern Ireland to the walled city of Derry. Feel the pulse of its storied streets, pause at the iconic Free Derry Wall, then glide back into County Donegal for two nights at the 4* Harveys Point Hotel. Voted the TripAdvisor Travellers' Choice No. 1 Hotel in Ireland for 2023, it sits right on the mirrored waters of Lough Eske—a perfect finale to a long day of discovery.

Mon July 20th - Day 4 - Slieve League Cliffs-Killybegs-Donegal

Donegal was crowned "Coolest Place on the Planet" by National Geographic Traveller in 2017—and today, you'll find out exactly why. After breakfast, we'll wind our way through the bustling fishing port of Killybegs and climb to the edge of Europe's tallest sea cliffs at Slieve League, where the Atlantic waves crash far below. In the afternoon, we will return to the luxury of Harvey's Point, where the afternoon is yours: wander the pristine lakeshore, lounge in the elegant grounds, or simply soak up the views. Then, freshen up for the dinner in the hotel's acclaimed restaurant that we have included for you —an idyllic end to a day of wild beauty and relaxation..

Tue July 21st - Day 5 - Donegal to Galway

This morning we bid farewell to Donegal and hug the legendary Wild Atlantic Way, winding through Sligo's heather-topped hills and Mayo's rugged shores before plunging into the untamed beauty of Connemara. Each mile teases you with crashing waves, hidden bays, and vistas that steal your breath. Our final destination is Galway, "The City of the Tribes" where we will take a short tour, past the storied Spanish Arch, inhaling the Atlantic's salt air along Salthill's promenade, and weave through medieval lanes alive with color and song. Tonight, we will settle into the Park House Hotel just off Eyre Square in the very centre of Galway—your launchpad for Galway's evening magic. Cross the Square into the buzzing heart of town, where every pub and restaurant pulses with the finest Irish music and laughter.

Wed July 22nd - Day 6 - Cliffs of Moher - Bunratty Castle Banquet

This morning, you'll depart Galway and follow Clare's rugged coastline to one of Ireland's most awe-inspiring landmarks: the Cliffs of Moher. You'll stand atop the towering precipices, then climb aboard a boat that slips into the Atlantic's rolling swell, revealing the cliffs in their elemental, sea-forged glory. As evening falls, you'll arrive at the elegant the Shannon Springs Hotel, just minutes from the 15th-century stronghold of Bunratty Castle. Behind its ancient walls awaits a Medieval Banquet: feasting in the great hall, lively Irish music, a banquet overflowing with sumptuous dishes, fine wines, and honeyed mead. When the last notes fade and the final toast is made, we'll escort you back to your hotel for a well-earned rest.



Thurs July 23rd -Day 7-Dingle Peninsula - Killarney Co Kerry

We take our leave of Clare and head down to the 'Kingdom' of Kerry, as the locals like to call it. Once there we'll head out onto the Dingle Peninsula, where we will visit the quaint fishing port of Dingle itself, before heading on to Slea Head to take in the fabulous scenery. We then travel to The Gleneagle Hotel in the world famous town of Killarney, your home for the next two nights where you have the evening free to chase live music down winding lanes, sink into snug pubs, and taste the true heart of Killarney after dark.



Fri July 24th Day 8 - Ring of Kerry - Kissanes Sheep Farm

Today you'll embark on what is reputed to be one of Europe's most scenic drives: the Ring of Kerry. We'll ascend to the mist-wreathed heights of Moll's Gap, where we will watch expert sheepdogs dart across Kissane's Sheep Farm, rounding up flocks with breathtaking precision followed by a live sheep shearing that brings the farm to life. Next, you'll pause at iconic Ladies View and take in the sweeping panorama of Killarney's lakes shimmering below. In the evening, we return to the Gleneagle Hotel for a dinner we have arranged there for you. Then let the night unfold your way: the Gleneagle often hosts concerts, with free access to residents or perhaps take a jaunt into Killarney's magical pubs - or maybe try both!

Sat July 25th - Day 9- Blarney Castle - Cobh Heritage Centre

This morning we will head eastward into Cork, Ireland's famed "Rebel County." Your first stop is Blarney Castle—scale its ancient walls to kiss the legendary Blarney Stone and ignite your gift of eloquence. If heights aren't your thing, lose yourself instead in the castle's lush gardens or wander through the world's largest emporium of Irish woolens at the historic Woolen Mills. Next, we journey to the windswept docks of Cobh, the Titanic's final port of call. Step inside the riveting Cobh Heritage Centre to retrace the ship's last moments and honor the countless Irish souls who set sail for new worlds. Our final destination is the The Fota Island Resort, a fabulous 5-Star hotel, based on its own private island, where you have the evening free to enjoy the resort's facilities and extensive grounds.

Sun July 26th - Day 10 - Rock of Cashel - Merry Ploughboy Show

Forget the old chorus that it's a Long Way To Tipperary - it is not if you start from Cork! We will head north to the legendary Rock of Cashel. Towering over the lush Tipperary plain, these ancient ramparts once cradled the throne of the High Kings of Munster in the fifth century. Feel history pulse beneath your feet as you explore its medieval chapels, round towers, and Celtic carvings. In the afternoon we whisk you back to Dublin's chic Mespil Hotel, where you will have a chance to freshen up before we embark on the grand finale of your tour, at the Merry Ploughboy Pub, nestled in the shadow of the Dublin Mountains. Settle in for a three-course feast of hearty Irish fare, then let the all-star lineup of musicians and dancers ignite the room. From foot-stomping jigs to haunting ballads, this award-winning Irish Night Show will send you home on a high note—though you're free to linger over one last nightcap at the hotel bar.

Mon July 27th - The Sad Part - The Return To The USA

Alas, all good things must come to an end, and you have now arrived at the saddest bit of any vacation - the return home. Thanks to Ireland's US Preclearance facility, you'll breeze right through immigration here, turning your transatlantic leg into a domestic arrival in the States—no lines, no hassle and we will make sure to get you out to the airport in good time. We hope that you will bring home many happy memories of your time with us in Ireland, whether it is the thunder of the Cliffs of Moher, the sparkle of Gaelic laughter, or the genuine warmth of every Irish welcome. - ** Many guests prefer to use their own air miles or airline status, so flight costs to Ireland are not included in the prices above. If you'd like us to arrange your flights, just let us know. Airline fares fluctuate based on booking lead time, departure airport, and seat availability, so we will confirm the exact cost when you're ready to book and invoice you separately. If you arrange your own flights, please aim to land in Dublin as close as possible to 7:00 AM local time (five hours ahead of Eastern) so you can join up with the other members of the group and avoid missing any part of the tour..
- Because we are an Irish company, all payment amounts are quoted in Euro. The
 amount payable in US Dollars is likely to differ depending on the Euro/Dollar exchange
 rate at the time any payments are made.
- Single-room supplements in Ireland make a solo room almost as expensive as a twin or double for two. If you are traveling alone and can team up with another solo guest to share a twin room, you'll both enjoy significant savings..
- A 20% non-refundable deposit is payable at the time of booking to reserve your place on the tour. The balance will be due four months prior to the travel date, and will be non-refundable once paid.

• A monthly payment plan option is available if enough elapsed time is available between the booking and final payment date



TERMS & CONDITIONS

At Ireland US Experience we like to keep things simple, so we don't have reams of tightly packed legal talk that you probably won't ever read or actually understand. What we want to do, when you travel with us, is to ensure that we give you the best possible vacation that we possibly can, and to make sure that you have such an enjoyable and safe time while you are in our care that you will remember and talk about it for years to come. However, there are a few things that we need to highlight to you, so that you are aware of them prior to travelling with us:

- We are an Irish company, based in Ireland, so any bills or invoices we send to you will be denominated in Euro. The actual amount in dollars may be higher or lower depending on the actual exchange rate on the dates the payments are made. We currently invoice through Paypal as we find that our visitors are more comfortable making their payments through a payment system that they are familiar with. Please note that you do not need to have a Paypal account to use this facility, and can instead use your debit or credit card as normal via their secure portal. Paypal will automatically handle the Euro/Dollar conversion for you at whatever rate applies on the day that you make the payment.
- Again, because we are an Irish company, based in Ireland, all dealings with us will be deemed to come under the jurisdiction of Irish law and the Irish courts system, or where they might take precedence, the laws of the UK or the European Union.
- Ireland US Experience Ltd undertake to supply the tour services agreed with our clients, which will usually have been customized to their particular requirements. Should any particular service or accommodation become unavailable at the time of the vacation, due to circumstances beyond our control, we agree to replace the missing item with a similar event or hotel of a similar standard. In return for these services, the client confirms that they will pay the amount agreed.
- Where you have requested us to create a Vacation Package that is customized to match your specific requirements then it will be priced based on an agreed number of passengers, travelling on agreed dates. Should the number of passengers or dates changes, then this may result in an adjustment to the price per person. Please note, in particular, that single occupancy rooms will normally be more expensive per person than joint occupancy. In addition, hotel accommodation costs tend to increase, and availability can be limited, during the high season (July to August). Hotel prices also tend to be more expensive when bookings are made close to the arrival date, or depending on the day of the week. Prices quoted by us for customized tours could therefore require amendment in situations where you request us to change your original travel or accommodation arrangements.
- An initial non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total amount due per person will normally be payable on confirmation of the booking. The remaining balance will be payable four months prior to the commencement of the vacation. We will invoice you, at the appropriate times, for the Euro amounts based on the overall price agreed at the time the booking was made. Final payments, once paid, become non-refundable. We would recommend that when travelling long distances, such as to Ireland, that you take out travel insurance that is appropriate to your circumstances. You can consult with your insurance advisor about suitable options or, alternatively, many major insurance companies offer a range of online policies that can be purchased directly from their websites.
- All entrance costs to the visitor attractions listed in the itinerary that we agree with our clients are included in the price. When requesting us to arrange games of golf, please advise if you would like us to also arrange clubs or buggies and if there are specific courses or types of courses you would like to play.
- As a tour operator, we look after you from the moment you arrive at the airport until the moment we return you to the airport at the end of your vacation. We do not arrange the flights themselves, but can recommend local US or Irish based travel agents who can supply these services at highly competitive rates. All prices quoted by us therefore exclude flight costs unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that international flight costs fluctuate, and can either increase or decrease substantially the closer you get to your departure date, and depending on how full a particular flight might be. In general, flight costs will be higher and availability lower in peak season (June to August), so you will need to take this into account when budgeting the overall cost of the vacation.
- If travellers have any special requirements (e.g. smoking rooms, handicap accessible rooms, bedding type, air conditioning, special dietary requirements) please advise at time of booking. Once hotels have confirmed, guests may incur penalties for any changes. Any special requests are subject to their availability at individual hotels and requests cannot be guaranteed.
- In the unlikely event of a medical emergency or issue, our staff will arrange for local medical assistance and transfer to a local hospital, should that be required. While public healthcare is free in Ireland for emergency admittances, if you wished to have private healthcare facilities you will need to ensure that your US health or travel insurance policy covers you for costs incurred outside the USA.
- It is the responsibility of all clients to ensure that they have valid passports before they travel. We recommend that you apply for your passport as early as possible if you do not currently have one, or if it will be out of date prior to your departure/return in order to avoid any last minute issues. Please ensure, when booking your flights, that you notify the travel agent of the exact names of all travellers as listed on their passports, as the airlines may not allow you to board the flight if there is a difference between the passport name and the name on the boarding pass.

Gratuities to drivers/guides are not included in our prices.

Any additional Terms and Conditions that might apply to specific vacation packages will be notified to you when agreeing theitinerary.
