

Fri July 4th - Day 1 - Dublin Airport Pickup - Teeling Whiskey

Welcome to Ireland! Your driver, Pat, will be in the Arrivals area of Dublin Airport at 2.45pm to meet you when you land (he will have a sign with your name and our logo to help you identify him).

After the long flight over you might like the opportunity to chill out while you find out the story of one of Ireland's second favorite beverages, when he takes you to Teeling Whiskey, located in the Liberties in the heart of Dublin city. Here you will discover the process that transforms simple ingredients into liquid gold, and, of course you will have the opportunity to sample the end result!

He will then take you to the hotel you have previously arranged yourselves for your stay in Dublin, The Morgan. This is located in the Temple Bar area, Dublin's equivalent of the Left Bank in Paris, full of vibrant pubs and restaurants. Pat will take you through the plans for your next few days with us and advise you of some good places to eat and to experience the hospitality for which Ireland is so famous.

Sat July 5th - Day 2 - Dublin Tour - Guinness - Merry Ploughboy Show

Today Pat will collect you from your hotel and take you on a tour around Dublin showing you some of the highlights and landmarks of the Capital City of Ireland, including the Phoenix Park, the largest enclosed in-city park in Europe where deer wander freely and includes the Wellington Monument, the Papal Cross, the residence of the American Ambassador to Ireland and Aras An Uachtaráin (the Irish "White House" and home of the President of Ireland) and even Dublin Zoo.

In the afternoon we will pay a visit to Dublin's most famous location, the Guinness Storehouse, officially the most visited attraction in the Republic of Ireland, and you will find out why when you see the panoramic view out over the city from the Gravity Bar as you learn how to pull a proper pint of 'the Black Stuff'.

We then return you to your hotel for a chance to freshen up before heading out for an evening of entertainment, in what is considered to be one of Ireland's most entertaining shows, that includes a spectacular display of Irish dancing and music accompanied by a full three course meal in the Merry Ploughboy Pub in the shadow of the Dublin mountains. We will then return you to your hotel.



HOWTH HEAD

Sun July 6th - Day 3 - Newgrange - Trim Castle

Today we venture outside Dublin to the Boyne Valley in County Meath, where you will be taken on a guided tour by a local guide of some of Ireland's oldest sites, including the megalithic passage tomb of Newgrange that pre-dates the Pyramids in Egypt, and where at dawn on the morning of the Spring and Winter Solstice, a beam of light penetrates all the way through to the central chamber inside. Then it is on to Trim Castle, where you will have the chance to explore this 13th century fortress used as the backdrop in several movies including Mel Gibson's Braveheart and Christian Bales's Reign of Fire. We will then return you to your hotel in Dublin for the evening where you can relax, or explore Temple Bar or the city centre at your own pace, maybe enjoying a pint or two!

Mon July 7th - Day 4 - Cliffs of Moher - Blarney Castle - Cork

Today you have made your own arrangements to visit some of Ireland's most iconic sites around the country.

Tues July 8th - Day 5 - Royal Dublin Golf Club / Trip To Howth Head

Today the group will split. Pat will take some of you to The Royal Dublin Golf Club where they will have a round of golf on a magnificent links course located on Bull Island Nature Reserve on the northern outskirts of Dublin City, that has hosted over 50 major amateur and professional championships, including The Irish Open on no less than six occasions since it was founded in 1885. (We understand that the golf is being organized by the golfers themselves).

He will then take the non-golfers, to the nearby bustling fishing town of Howth, and then on to Howth Head where they too can take in the sea air with fantastic views and great walks looking down over Dublin Bay.

On completion of the golf the entire group will return to your hotel to allow you to enjoy your last night in Dublin.

Pat will do two runs to the airport, initially for those taking the 11.45am flight, and will then return to collect those taking the 3.25pm flight. As all US Immigration processes actually take place in Dublin Airport, we need to ensure that you are at the airport in good time to be processed and make your flight. As you will have been pre-processed in Dublin, you will not need to go through immigration when you arrive in the USA and it will be just like arriving on a domestic US flight. We hope that you will bring back with you many happy memories of your time with us in Ireland.

* Because we are an Irish company, all payment amounts are quoted in Euro. The amount payable in US Dollars may be higher depending on the Euro/Dollar exchange rate at the time payments are made.

Our usual terms are that a 20% non-refundable deposit is normally payable at the time of booking with the balance due four months prior to the travel date. However, because we are well within that time-frame, the full payment would be due when booking.

The cost of the tour includes entrance fees to all attractions listed and to the Merry Ploughboy Show plus all transportation as listed, including airport pickup and return, with your own private chauffeur. It does not include flights, accommodation, the cost of your day-trip to the Cliffs of Moher/Cork or the costs associated with the golf at Royal Dublin, which we understand have been booked by you separately.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

At Ireland US Experience we like to keep things simple, so we don't have reams of tightly packed legal talk that you probably won't ever read or actually understand. What we want to do, when you travel with us, is to ensure that we give you the best possible vacation that we possibly can, and to make sure that you have such an enjoyable and safe time while you are in our care that you will remember and talk about it for years to come. However, there are a few things that we need to highlight to you, so that you are aware of them prior to travelling with us :

We are an Irish company, based in Ireland, so any bills or invoices we send you will be denominated in Euro. The actual amount in dollars may be higher or lower depending on the actual exchange rate on the dates the payments are made. We currently invoice through Paypal as we find that our visitors are more comfortable making their payments through a payment system that they are familiar with. Please note that you do not need to have a Paypal account to use this facility, and can instead use your debit or credit card as normal via their secure portal. Paypal will automatically handle the Euro/Dollar conversion for you at whatever rate applies on the day that you make the payment.

Again, because we are an Irish company, based in Ireland, all dealings with us will be deemed to come under the jurisdiction of Irish law and the Irish courts system, or where they might take precedence, the laws of the UK or the European Union.

Ireland US Experience Ltd undertake to supply the tour services agreed with our clients, which will usually have been customized to their particular requirements. Should any particular service or accommodation become unavailable at the time of the vacation, due to circumstances beyond our control, we agree to replace the missing item with a similar event or hotel of a similar standard. In return for these services, the client confirms that they will pay the amount agreed.

The Vacation Package will be priced based on an agreed number of passengers on agreed dates. If the number of passengers or dates changes, then this may result in an adjustment to the price per person. Please note, in particular, that single occupancy rooms will normally be more expensive per person than joint occupancy. In addition, hotel accommodation costs tend to increase, and availability can be limited, during the high season (August to August). Hotel prices also tend to be more expensive when bookings are made close to the arrival date, or on different days of the week. Prices quoted by us could therefore require amendment in situations where you request us to change your original travel or accommodation arrangements.

An initial non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total amount due per person will normally be payable on confirmation of the booking. The remaining balance will be payable four months prior to the commencement of the vacation. We will invoice you, at the appropriate times, for the Euro amounts based on the overall price agreed at the time the booking was made. Final payments, once paid, become non-refundable. We would recommend that when travelling long distances, such as to Ireland, that you take out travel insurance that is appropriate to your circumstances. A basic travel insurance policy is included as part of your package and details will be notified to you along with your flight confirmations. If you wish to have a more comprehensive cover, you should consult your insurance advisor.

All entrance costs to the visitor attractions listed in the itinerary that we agree with our clients are included in the price. When requesting us to arrange games of golf, please advise if you would like us to also arrange clubs or buggies and if there are specific courses or types of courses you would like to play.

As a tour operator, we look after you from the moment you arrive at the airport until the moment we return you to the airport at the end of your vacation. We do not usually arrange the flights themselves, but can recommend local US or Irish based travel agents who can supply these services at highly competitive rates. All prices quoted by us therefore exclude flight costs unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that international flight costs fluctuate, and can either increase or decrease substantially the closer you get to your departure date, depending on how full a particular flight might be. In general, flight costs will be higher and availability lower in peak season (June to August), so you will need to take this into account when budgeting the overall cost of the vacation.

If travellers have any special requirements (e.g. smoking rooms, handicap accessible rooms, bedding type, air conditioning, special dietary requirements) please advise at time of booking. Once hotels have confirmed, guests may incur penalties for any changes. Any special requests are subject to their availability at individual hotels and requests cannot be guaranteed.

In the unlikely event of a medical emergency or issue, our staff will arrange for local medical assistance and transfer to a local hospital, should that be required. While public healthcare is free in Ireland for emergency admittances, if you wished to have private healthcare facilities you will need to ensure that your US health policy covers you for costs incurred outside the USA.

It is the responsibility of all clients to ensure that they have valid passports before they travel. We recommend that you apply for your passport as early as possible if you do not currently have one, or if it will be out of date prior to your departure/return in order to avoid any last minute issues. Please ensure, when booking your flights, that you notify the travel agent of the exact names of all travellers as listed on their passports, as the airlines may not allow you to board the flight if there is a difference between the passport name and the name on the boarding pass.

Gratuities to drivers/guides are not included in our prices.

Any additional Terms and Conditions that might apply to specific vacation packages will be notified to you when agreeing the itinerary.
