Day 1 Wednesday June 2nd 2021 – DEPARTURE FROM THE USA

Day 2 Thursday June 3rd 2021 DUBLIN - Tour of Dublin, Kilmainham Gaol, Guinness Storehouse H

Welcome to Ireland! On your arrival in Dublin Airport this morning, you will met, by your chauffeur and guide for the duration of the tour. He will ease you into your trip by taking you on a tour of his native city, Dublin, taking in some its main sights and places of interest. Our main visits of the day will be to Kilmainham Gaol, which is steeped in Irish revolutionary history and the Guinness Storehouse, Ireland's most popular visitors attraction, and home of it's most iconic export, where you will get the chance to pull a pint of the "black stuff". Day 3 Fri June 4th 2021 – MEATH-Newgrange, Hill of Tara & Trinity College/Book of Kells

Today we venture outside Dublin to the Boyne Valley in County Meath, where you will be taken on a guided tour by a local guide of some of Irelands oldest sites, including the megalithic passage tomb of Newgrange, pre-dating the Pyramids in Egypt, and the Hill of Tara, former

seat of the High Kings of Ireland. In the afternoon, we will return to Dublin City Centre, to Trinity College where you will get to ramble around the grounds and visit the fabulous Book of Kells, a hand-illustrated illuminated manuscript dating back to 800 A.D. We then return to our hotel for a chance to freshen up before heading out for a night of entertainment and a three-course meel at the Merry Ploughboy Irish Night, in the shadow of the Dublin Mountains.

Day 4 Sat June 5th 2021 – GALWAY Via Athlone Including Boat Trip To Clonmacnoise

This morning, we will head off across the midlands of Ireland, stopping off in Athlone, located in the center of Ireland, for lunch, including a visit to Sean’s Bar, reputed to be the oldest bar in Ireland, before taking a boat ride from Athlone to the ancient monastic site of Clonmacnoise. From there you will be picked up and transported to your hotel located right in the very heart of Galway, where you will have the evening free to enjoy the vibrant city life, or rest up for the evening.

Day 5 Sun June 6th 2021 – GALWAY – Tour of Connemara

Today we will travel around the Connemara Loop, driving initially along the Wild Atlantic Way coastal route to Clifden, and then through the wild Connemara countryside and Connemara National Park, stopping off at Maams Cross and Cong, location for the John Wayne movie The Quiet Man, before returning to your hotel for the evening.

Day 6 Mon June 7th 2021 – CLARE – Cliffs of Moher By Boat, Burren, Adare

We take our leave of Galway this morning, and head south into County Clare where we will get to view one of Ireland’s most iconic sights, The Cliffs of Moher, but see it as few others have seen it, from the ocean side when we take a boat trip along the length of the cliffs. Then we are back on the road, heading south across the Burren, where its distinctive eco-climate has resulted in the growth of many rare plant species. We then continue towards the ‘Kingdom of Kerry’, as the locals like to call it, taking a shortcut across the Shannon Estuary on the Killimer to Tarbert Ferry before arriving in one of Ireland’s most famous towns, Killarney, where you will have the evening free to explore the town..

Day 7 Tue June 8th 2021 KERRY – The Ring of Kerry, Sheep Farm and Muckross House

Today we embark on a tour featuring some of the most spectacular scenery in the world, as we tour the famed 'Ring of Kerry', visiting high points like Lady's View, Molls Gap, Waterville (where you may be surprised to find a statue of Charlie Chaplin who spent many of his later summers there with his family), and view the Skellig Islands featured in the recent Star Wars movies. Along the way we will visit a sheep farm where you will get to see how the farm is run, and witness how the farmers use their sheep dogs to herd their flocks. We will finish up back in Killarney where we will visit the grounds of Muckross House in the National Park on the shores of the famed Lakes of Killarney. You will then have the evening free to enjoy the delights of Killarney

Day 8 Wed June 9th 2021 – KERRY- Dingle Peninsula, Brandon, Conor Pass, Dingle

Today we travel out to the Dingle Peninsula full of spectacularly long beaches like Inch, used as a location in the movie Ryan's Daughter, where we will travel to scenic Brandon Point, stopping off for a coffee in Murphys pub in the village of Brandon, located beside its pier. Then we will travel across the Conor Pass and down into the fishing town officially known as Daingean Uí Chúis, but better known as Dingle, that gives the peninsula its name, a town full of great charm and lots and lots of pubs and places to eat, particularly if you like sea food. On our way back we will stop off at the South Pole Inn pub in Annascaul, home of the Antarctic Irish explorer Tom Crean, who travelled on both the Shackleton and Scott expeditions. Our journey for the day ends when we arrive in Tralee where we book into our hotel for the evening, the gorgeous Ballyseede Castle Hotel.

Day 9 Thurs June 10th 2021 – CORK – Glengarriff and Cork Coastal Route

This morning, after breakfast, wil journey from Kerry to Country Cork, where we will visit scenic Glengarriff and take a leasurly dirve along the Cork coastline via the fishing villages of Cobh (the last landfall that Titanic made before her fateful voyage, and where you will have the chance to visit the Cobh Titanic Experience) and on to the only 5 Star hotel in Cork, the renowned Fota Island Resort Hotel and Spa, with its grounds located on its own private island.

Day 10 Fri June 11th 2021 – KILKENNY – via Blarney Castle & the Rock of Cashel



We depart Cork, and make our way towards Kilkenny. Our first stop will at Blarney Castle, the location for the Blarney Stone, the kissing of which is reputed to give you the Gift of Elequence (or the Gift of the Gab as they call it in Ireland). While in the grounds of the Castle you will have the opportunity to visit the Blarney Woolen Mills, where some excellent examples of Itraditional and modern Irish fashions. Then we head northwards again, stopping off at another iconic Irish location, the Rock of Cashel, While most of the current buidings date back to the 12th century, it ws the seat of the High Kings of Munster, where famously one of the High Kings in the 5th century was reputed to have been converted to Christianity by Saint Patrick. Then finally, we move on to our destination for this evening, the “Marble City” of Kilkenny, where you will be spending the night in the 5 Star Lyrath Estate Hotel located on 170 acres.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

At Ireland US Experience we like to keep things simple, so we don't have reams of tightly packed legal talk that you probably won't ever read or actually understand. What we want to do, when you travel with us, is to ensure that we give you the best possible vacation that we possibly can, and to make sure that you have such an enjoyable and safe time while you are in our care that you will remember and talk about it for years to come. However, there are a few things that we need to highlight to you, so that you are aware of them prior to travelling with us :

- We are an Irish company, based in Ireland, so any bills or invoices we send you will be denominated in Euro. The actual amount in dollars may be higher or lower depending on the actual exchange rate on the dates the payments are made. We currently invoice through Paypal as we find that our visitors are more comfortable making their payments through a payment system that they are familiar with. Please note that you do not need to have a Paypal account to use this facility, and can instead use your debit or credit card as normal via their secure portal. Paypal will automatically handle the Euro/Dollar conversion for you at whatever rate applies on the day that you make the payment.
- Again, because we are an Irish company, based in Ireland, all dealings with us will be deemed to come under the jurisdiction of Irish law and the Irish courts system, or where they might take precedence, the laws of the UK or the European Union.
- Ireland US Experience Ltd undertake to supply the tour services agreed with our clients, which will usually have been customized to their particular requirements. Should any particular service or accommodation become unavailable at the time of the vacation, due to circumstances beyond our control, we agree to replace the missing item with a similar event or hotel of a similar standard. In return for these services, the client confirms that they will pay the amount agreed.
- The Vacation Package will be priced based on an agreed number of passengers on agreed dates. If the number of passengers or dates changes, then this may result in an adjustment to the price per person. Please note, in particular, that single occupancy rooms will normally be more expensive per person than joint occupancy. In addition, hotel accommodation costs tend to increase, and availability can be limited, during the high season (June to August). Hotel prices also tend to be more expensive when bookings are made close to the arrival date, or on different days of the week. Prices quoted by us could therefore require amendment in situations where you request us to change your original travel or accommodation arrangements.
- An initial non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total amount due per person will normally be payable on confirmation of the booking. The remaining balance will be payable four months prior to the commencement of the vacation. We will invoice you, at the appropriate times, for the Euro amounts based on the overall price agreed at the time the booking was made. Final payments, once paid, become non-refundable. We would recommend that when travelling long distances, such as to Ireland, that you take out travel insurance that is appropriate to your circumstances. A basic travel insurance policy is included as part of your package and details will be notified to you along with your flight confirmations. If you wish to have a more comprehensive cover, you should consult your insurance advisor.
- All entrance costs to the visitor attractions listed in the itinerary that we agree with our clients are included in the price. When requesting us to arrange games of golf, please advise if you would like us to also arrange clubs or buggies and if there are specific courses or types of courses you would like to play.

- As a tour operator, we look after you from the moment you arrive at the airport until the moment we return you to the airport at the end of your vacation. We do not arrange the flights themselves, but can recommend local US or Irish based travel agents who can supply these services at highly competitive rates. All prices quoted by us therefore exclude flight costs unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that international flight costs fluctuate, and can either increase or decrease substantially the closer you get to your departure date, depending on how full a particular flight might be. In general, flight costs will be higher and availability lower in peak season (July to August), so you will need to take this into account when budgeting the overall cost of the vacation.
- If travellers have any special requirements (e.g. smoking rooms, handicap accessible rooms, bedding type, air conditioning, special dietary requirements) please advise at time of booking. Once hotels have confirmed, guests may incur penalties for any changes. Any special requests are subject to their availability at individual hotels and requests cannot be guaranteed.
- In the unlikely event of a medical emergency or issue, our staff will arrange for local medical assistance and transfer to a local hospital, should that be required. While public healthcare is free in Ireland for emergency admittances, if you wished to have private healthcare facilities you will need to ensure that your US health policy covers you for costs incurred outside the USA.
- It is the responsibility of all clients to ensure that they have valid passports before they travel. We recommend that you apply for your passport as early as possible if you do not currently have one, or if it will be out of date prior to your departure/return in order to avoid any last minute issues. Please ensure, when booking your flights, that you notify the travel agent of the exact names of all travellers as listed on their passports, as the airlines may not allow you to board the flight if there is a difference between the passport name and the name on the boarding pass.
- Gratuities to drivers/guides are not included in our prices.
- Any additional Terms and Conditions that might apply to specific vacation packages will be notified to you when agreeing the itinerary.
