Thurs July 15th - Depart The USA On Your Journey To Ireland

Your journey to Ireland begins as you fly out from the USA across the Atlantic Ocean.

Fri July 16th - Day 1 - Dublin-Kilmainham Gaol-Guinness Storehouse

Welcome to Ireland! Your driver and guide will be waiting to greet you in the Arrivals Hall at Dublin Airport. Once we have everyone on board, we'll begin your Irish adventure with a scenic introduction to Dublin—our vibrant capital city. As we make our way into town, you'll enjoy a short highlights tour, including a stop in Phoenix Park, the largest walled city park in Europe. Keep an eye out for the resident herd of wild deer and the elegant Áras an Uachtaráin, official residence of Ireland's President—often called *Ireland's White House*. Next, we step back in time with a powerful visit to Kilmainham Gaol, one of the most important historic sites in the country. Here, you'll walk in the footsteps of Ireland's revolutionary leaders and hear the stories that shaped the nation. From there, we head to one of Dublin's most iconic attractions: the world-famous Guinness Storehouse.

Discover the story behind Ireland's most beloved export, learn how to pour the perfect pint of "the Black Stuff," and take in sweeping 360° views of the city from the Gravity Bar—pint in hand. Afterward, we'll check you into your home for the first two nights, [The Mespil Hotel](#), beautifully set along the leafy banks of the Grand Canal and just a short stroll from Dublin's city center. Join your guides for a welcome drink as they walk you through the full itinerary and share insider tips on Dublin's hidden gems. The rest of the evening is yours to unwind. Relax at the hotel, take a peaceful canal-side walk, pop into a local pub, or head into the lively Temple Bar district (about a 15–20 minute walk or a quick cab ride) to experience Dublin's legendary nightlife. And remember: a pint of Guinness in Ireland tastes like nowhere else on Earth.

Sat July 17th - Day 2 - Dublin - EPIC Museum -Teeling Whiskey

Start your morning with a classic full Irish breakfast, then get ready to explore Ireland's remarkable global story. Your first stop is the award-winning EPIC Irish Emigration Museum, a cutting-edge, interactive experience voted *Europe's Leading Tourist Attraction* three years in a row. Here, you'll discover how a small island on the edge of Europe shaped music, politics, science, sports, and culture across the world—including in the United States. Just steps away, we'll cross over to the Dublin Harbour Quays to board the *Jeanie Johnston*, an exact replica of the Famine-era ships that carried early Irish emigrants to America. Standing on its deck, you'll gain a powerful sense of the courage and hope that fueled the Irish journey to the New World. In the afternoon, we shift gears entirely with a visit to Teeling Whiskey Distillery, the first new distillery to open in Dublin in over a century. You'll learn how humble ingredients—grain, yeast, and water—are transformed into Ireland's signature "liquid gold." And yes, you'll raise a glass and enjoy a guided tasting of their award-winning whiskeys. As we make our way back, you'll take in more of Dublin's highlights before returning to your hotel for a relaxing evening. Whether you prefer to unwind in your room, stroll to a nearby pub, or head back into the city for another pint, the night is yours to enjoy.

Sun July 18th - Day 3 - Titanic Belfast - Derry - Donegal

This morning, we say goodbye to Dublin and make our way up Ireland's beautiful East Coast toward Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland. Though we'll be crossing the border from the Republic of Ireland into the United Kingdom, the transition is so seamless you'll barely notice it. Once in Belfast, enjoy a short panoramic tour of the city before we step inside one of the world's great museum experiences: Titanic Belfast, crowned *The World's Top Visitor Attraction* in 2017. Here, you'll follow the story of the famous ship from its very first sketches to its final, fateful night in 1912. Walk through immersive galleries, stand where the ship was built, and feel the scale and ambition behind the world's most legendary ocean liner. From Belfast, we travel west across Northern Ireland to the historic walled city of Derry. Take in the dramatic city walls, and pause at the iconic Free Derry Wall, a powerful symbol of the city's modern history. Then it's time to unwind as we cross back into the Republic of Ireland and arrive in County Donegal for a two-night stay at the award-winning [Harvey's Point Hotel](#). Voted TripAdvisor's *No. 1 Hotel in Ireland* for 2023, this 4-Star lakeside retreat sits right on the shimmering shores of Lough Eske - a peaceful, picture-perfect setting after a full day of discovery. Settle in, breathe in the fresh Donegal air, and enjoy the calm of one of Ireland's most beautiful corners.

Mon July 19th - Day 4 - Slieve League Cliffs-Killybegs-Donegal

Donegal earned the title of "Coolest Place on the Planet" from National Geographic Traveller in 2017. and today, you'll see exactly what captured their imagination. After a hearty breakfast, we set off through the charming fishing port of Killybegs, watching the trawlers and colorful boats that keep this coastal town buzzing with life. From there, the road climbs toward one of Ireland's most breathtaking natural wonders: Slieve League, home to some of the tallest sea cliffs in all of Europe. Standing at the edge, you'll feel the Atlantic wind on your face and hear the waves thundering hundreds of feet below—an unforgettable moment of raw, untamed beauty. In the afternoon, we return to the comfort and luxury of Harvey's Point. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy as you wish: stroll along the peaceful shores of Lough Eske, relax on the hotel's immaculate grounds, or simply settle into a quiet corner and take in the sweeping mountain and lakeside views. As evening falls, freshen up for a special dinner in the hotel's acclaimed restaurant—a meal we've included for you. With its warm atmosphere, exceptional cuisine, and stunning lakeside setting, it's the perfect way to end a day filled with epic landscapes and pure Donegal serenity.

Tue July 20th - Day 5 - Donegal to Galway

This morning, we bid farewell to Donegal and follow the legendary Wild Atlantic Way, one of the world's great coastal drives. The road carries us through Sligo's heather-clad hills and along Mayo's rugged shoreline, where the horizon seems to stretch forever. Every mile offers another postcard moment—crashing surf, sweeping headlands, and landscapes that feel wonderfully untouched. Our journey leads us into the wild heart of Connemara, a region famed for its windswept mountains, glassy lakes, and endless skies. It's Ireland at its most dramatic and soulful. By afternoon, we arrive in Galway—"The City of the Tribes". We'll take a short tour through this vibrant coastal city: pass the historic Spanish Arch, breathe in the salty Atlantic air along the Salthill Promenade, and wander medieval streets alive with color, music, and the unmistakable Galway energy. Tonight, you'll settle into [The Park House Hotel](#), perfectly located just off Eyre Square in the very center of town. Step outside and you're moments from Galway's legendary nightlife - pubs spilling over with traditional music, restaurants buzzing with conversation, and a warm, lively atmosphere that makes this city unforgettable. Your Galway adventure begins the moment you cross the Square and dive into the heart of it all.

Wed July 21st - Day 6 - Cliffs of Moher - Bunratty Castle Banquet

This morning, we depart Galway and follow the wild, windswept coastline of County Clare toward one of Ireland's most iconic natural wonders: the Cliffs of Moher. You'll first experience these towering cliffs from above, standing on their dramatic edge as the Atlantic crashes far below. Then, for a completely different perspective, you'll board a boat that glides into the ocean swells, revealing the cliffs in all their raw, sea-carved majesty, an unforgettable sight from water level. As evening settles in, we arrive at the elegant [Shannon Springs Hotel](#), perfectly located just minutes from the 15th century fortress of Bunratty Castle. Behind its ancient stone walls, a feast awaits—the legendary Medieval Banquet. Step into the great hall for an evening of hearty food, flowing wine and honeyed mead, and lively Irish music that brings the Middle Ages back to life. You then return to your hotel to enjoy the rest of the evening.

Thurs July 22nd -Day 7- Dingle Peninsula - Killarney Co Kerry

This morning, we bid farewell to County Clare and make our way south into the legendary “Kingdom of Kerry,” as locals proudly call it. Our journey takes us onto the breathtaking Dingle Peninsula, a place where mountains tumble into the sea and every bend in the road reveals another postcard view. We’ll stop in the charming fishing town of Dingle, known for its colorful harbor, artisan shops, and lively coastal spirit. From there we continue out to Slea Head, one of the most spectacular stretches of coastline in Ireland. Here, the Atlantic crashes against rugged cliffs, ancient stone huts dot the hillsides, and the views stretch endlessly toward the Blasket Islands. By late afternoon, we arrive in the world-famous town of Killarney, where you’ll settle into the welcoming [Gleneagle Hotel](#), your home for the next two nights. Once checked in, the evening is yours to explore. Step out into Killarney’s winding lanes, follow the sound of fiddles and bodhráns, slip into a cozy pub for a pint, or savor dinner in one of the town’s many warm, bustling restaurants. Killarney after dark is pure Irish magic - music in the air, laughter in the streets, and a spirit that invites you to join right in.

Fri July 23rd Day 8 - Ring of Kerry - Kissanes Sheep Farm

Today, you’ll set out on one of Europe’s most celebrated scenic drives: the Ring of Kerry. This legendary route sweeps through mountains, lakes, and Atlantic coastline, revealing Ireland at its most dramatic and soul-stirring. We’ll climb toward the mist-kissed heights of Moll’s Gap, where the landscape opens into a panorama of rugged peaks and winding valleys. Here, you’ll visit Kissane’s Sheep Farm, a true highlight of the day. Watch expertly trained sheepdogs race across the hillsides, guiding their flocks with astonishing precision, followed by a live sheep-shearing demonstration that brings traditional farm life vividly to life. Next, we pause at the iconic Ladies View, named for Queen Victoria’s ladies-in-waiting, who were captivated by the sweeping vistas of Killarney’s lakes shimmering far below. It’s one of those moments where you simply stop, breathe, and take it all in. By evening, we return to the Gleneagle Hotel, where we’ve arranged a delicious dinner for you. Afterward, the night is yours. The Gleneagle hosts fantastic concerts— often with complimentary access for hotel guests - or you might wander back into Killarney to explore its magical pubs, each glowing with music, warmth, and that unmistakable Irish charm.

Sat July 24th - Day 9- Blarney Castle – Cobh Heritage Centre

This morning, we journey east into County Cork, proudly known as Ireland’s “Rebel County.” Your first stop is the legendary Blarney Castle, where you can climb its ancient stone steps and kiss the world-famous Blarney Stone—said to bestow the gift of eloquence on all who dare. If heights aren’t your style, you can wander the castle’s enchanting gardens or explore the historic Blarney Woollen Mills, home to the world’s largest collection of Irish woolens and crafts. Next, we continue to the colorful harbor town of Cobh, the Titanic’s final port of call. Standing on its windswept docks, you’ll feel the echoes of history. Inside the powerful Cobh Heritage Centre, you’ll retrace the Titanic’s last moments and discover the stories of the countless Irish emigrants who began their journeys to America from this very place. Our final destination is the spectacular [Fota Island Resort](#), a luxurious 5 Star retreat set on its own private island. Here, you’ll have the evening free to unwind, stroll the peaceful grounds, enjoy the resort’s exceptional facilities, or simply relax and savor the tranquility.

Sun July 25th - Day 10 - Rock of Cashel – Merry Ploughboy Show

Forget the old tune insisting It’s a Long Way to Tipperary—not when you’re starting from Cork. This morning, we head north into the heart of Ireland to visit one of its most iconic treasures: the Rock of Cashel. Rising dramatically above the green Tipperary plains, this ancient fortress was once the seat of the High Kings of Munster as far back as the 5th century. As you wander through its medieval chapels, round towers, and intricate Celtic carvings, you’ll feel centuries of Irish history echo beneath your feet. In the afternoon, we whisk you back to Dublin and check in once again at the [Mespil Hotel](#), giving you time to refresh before the grand finale of your journey. Tonight, we venture to the award-winning Merry Ploughboy Pub, tucked at the foothills of the Dublin Mountains. Settle in for a three-course feast of hearty Irish cuisine, then let the evening ignite around you. World-class musicians and dancers take the stage, filling the room with foot-stomping jigs, soaring ballads, and the kind of energy that makes Ireland unforgettable. When the final note fades and the last toast is raised, we’ll bring you back to your hotel where you may choose to linger over one final pint!

Mon July 26th - The Sad Part -The Return Home

All great adventures eventually reach their final chapter, and today we arrive at the hardest moment of any vacation - the journey home. But Ireland makes even goodbyes a little easier. Thanks to U.S. Preclearance at Dublin Airport, you'll clear US immigration before you fly, turning your transatlantic trip into a simple domestic arrival back in the States. No long lines, no stress, and we'll ensure you reach the airport with time to spare.

As you head home, we hope your suitcase is a little heavier with souvenirs, and your heart even fuller with memories. Perhaps it's the thunderous roar of the Cliffs of Moher, the sparkle of Gaelic laughter, or the genuine warmth of every Irish welcome that stays with you.

Airline fares fluctuate based on booking lead time, departure airport, and seat availability, so we will confirm the exact cost when you're ready to book and invoice you separately. If you arrange your own flights, please aim to land in Dublin as close as possible to 7:00 AM local time (five hours ahead of Eastern) so you can join up with the other members of the group and avoid missing any part of the tour.**
- **Because we are an Irish company, all payment amounts are quoted in Euro. The amount payable in US Dollars is likely to differ depending on the Euro/Dollar exchange rate at the time any payments are made.**
- **Single-room supplements in Ireland make a solo room almost as expensive as a twin or double for two. If you are traveling alone and can team up with another solo guest to share a twin room, you'll both enjoy significant savings.**
- **A 20% non-refundable deposit is payable at the time of booking to reserve your place on the tour. The balance will be due four months prior to the travel date, and will be non-refundable once paid.**

TERMS & CONDITIONS

At Ireland US Experience we like to keep things simple, so we don't have reams of tightly packed legal talk that you probably won't ever read or actually understand. What we want to do, when you travel with us, is to ensure that we give you the best possible vacation that we possibly can, and to make sure that you have such an enjoyable and safe time while you are in our care that you will remember and talk about it for years to come. However, there are a few things that we need to highlight to you, so that you are aware of them prior to travelling with us :

We are an Irish company, based in Ireland, so any bills or invoices we send to you will be denominated in Euro. The actual amount in dollars may be higher or lower depending on the actual exchange rate on the dates the payments are made. We currently invoice through Paypal as we find that our visitors are more comfortable making their payments through a payment system that they are familiar with. Please note that you do not need to have a Paypal account to use this facility, and can instead use your debit or credit card as normal via their secure portal. Paypal will automatically handle the Euro/Dollar conversion for you at whatever rate applies on the day that you make the payment.

Again, because we are an Irish company, based in Ireland, all dealings with us will be deemed to come under the jurisdiction of Irish law and the Irish courts system, or where they might take precedence, the laws of the UK or the European Union.

Ireland US Experience Ltd undertake to supply the tour services agreed with our clients, which will usually have been customized to their particular requirements. Should any particular service or accommodation become unavailable at the time of the vacation, due to circumstances beyond our control, we agree to replace the missing item with a similar event or hotel of a similar standard. In return for these services, the client confirms that they will pay the amount agreed.

Where you have requested us to create a Vacation Package that is customized to match your specific requirements then it will be priced based on an agreed number of passengers, travelling on agreed dates. Should the number of passengers or dates changes, then this may result in an adjustment to the price per person. Please note, in particular, that single occupancy rooms will normally be more expensive per person than joint occupancy. In addition, hotel accommodation costs tend to increase, and availability can be limited, during the high season (July to August). Hotel prices also tend to be more expensive when bookings are made close to the arrival date, or depending on the day of the week. Prices quoted by us for customized tours could therefore require amendment in situations where you request us to change your original travel or accommodation arrangements.

An initial non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total amount due per person will normally be payable on confirmation of the booking. The remaining balance will be payable four months prior to the commencement of the vacation. We will invoice you, at the appropriate times, for the Euro amounts based on the overall price agreed at the time the booking was made. Final payments, once paid, become non-refundable. We would recommend that when travelling long distances, such as to Ireland, that you take out travel insurance that is appropriate to your circumstances. You can consult with your insurance advisor about suitable options or, alternatively, many major insurance companies offer a range of online policies that can be purchased directly from their websites.

All entrance costs to the visitor attractions listed in the itinerary that we agree with our clients are included in the price. When requesting us to arrange games of golf, please advise if you would like us to also arrange clubs or buggies and if there are specific courses or types of courses you would like to play.

As a tour operator, we look after you from the moment you arrive at the airport until the moment we return you to the airport at the end of your vacation. We do not arrange the flights themselves, but can recommend local US or Irish based travel agents who can supply these services at highly competitive rates. All prices quoted by us therefore exclude flight costs unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that international flight costs fluctuate, and can either increase or decrease substantially the closer you get to your departure date, and depending on how full a particular flight might be. In general, flight costs will be higher and availability lower in peak season (June to August), so you will need to take this into account when budgeting the overall cost of the vacation.

If travellers have any special requirements (e.g. smoking rooms, handicap accessible rooms, bedding type, air conditioning, special dietary requirements) please advise at time of booking. Once hotels have confirmed, guests may incur penalties for any changes. Any special requests are subject to their availability at individual hotels and requests cannot be guaranteed.

In the unlikely event of a medical emergency or issue, our staff will arrange for local medical assistance and transfer to a local hospital, should that be required. While public healthcare is free in Ireland for emergency admittances, if you wished to have private health-care facilities you will need to ensure that your US health or travel insurance policy covers you for costs incurred outside the USA.

It is the responsibility of all clients to ensure that they have valid passports before they travel. We recommend that you apply for your passport as early as possible if you do not currently have one, or if it will be out of date prior to your departure/return in order to avoid any last minute issues. Please ensure, when booking your flights, that you notify the travel agent of the exact names of all travellers as listed on their passports, as the airlines may not allow you to board the flight if there is a difference between the passport name and the name on the boarding pass.

Gratuities to drivers/guides are not included in our prices.

Any additional Terms and Conditions that might apply to specific vacation packages will be notified to you when agreeing the itinerary.
